*Notes from the July 23, 2009 Regular Meeting of the Fayetteville Board of Education*

## **Selection Process for Architect and Construction Manager for New Fayetteville High School**

The Board voted 4-2 to begin a selection process to select an architect for the design of the new FHS. The Board also voted 5-1 to begin a selection process to select a construction manager for the new FHS.

The Board also voted 6-0 to grant authority to the preliminary selection committee to review statements of qualifications of the applicants and provide a list of five finalists for consideration by the Board.

## **Recognition Awards**

FHS golfers Olivia Lavy and Micah Radler received Recognition of Outstanding Achievement Awards for their achievements this summer in national and state golf tournaments.

## **QZAB Bonds Application**

The Board voted 6-0 to allow the district to submit an application for Qualified School Construction Bonds Application, which will provide a tax credit to the school district, as well as a lower interest rate on the construction bonds.

## **NSBA Site Visit**

Chief Academic Officer and project manager Patty Plummer reported to the Board on the site visit the district will host in March of 2010 for the National School Boards Association.

## **Campaign Report**

Board president Susan Heil reported on the millage campaign committee and their work toward the Sept. 15 school election.

Board president Susan Heil made a brief presentation to the Board on how the Board could become paperless and utilize electronic records for their meetings.
