The Board voted 7-0 to approve the 2009-2010 special education budget as presented.

Charter School Application

The Board voted 7-0 to disapprove the request for the open enrollment charter by Prism Education Center.

School Improvement Plan

The Board voted 7-0 to approve the district's submission of the district's Comprehensive School Improvement Plan as required by Arkansas law.
